- Can you clarify the Organization Chart for the Local Project by the OMJ Center.
- Can you clarify the definition of Consortium Members as it relates to Letter(s) of commitment.

Q: Can you clarify the Organization Chart for the Local Project by the OMJ Center?

A: The Organization Chart for the Local Project would entail your OMJ Center organizational chart. The Required Attachments section notates a requirement for your overall organizational chart, as well as any applicable organizational charts for the components in which your organization is submitting a proposal. For example, if you are applying for OMJ Operator, you would provide your OMJ Center Staff Organizational Chart.

Q: Can you clarify the definition of Consortium Members as it relates to Letter(s) of Commitment?

A: Per WIOA guidelines, consortiums can submit proposals to deliver services. Per section 1.2 of the RFP. I have referenced the portion of section 1.2 of the RFP, which demonstrates the eligible respondents.

"Consortiums, joint ventures, or collaborations of organizations with complementary skills and experience are permitted to respond to this RFP; however, the proposal must clearly demonstrate that all contractual responsibility rests solely with one legal entity serving as the Lead Agency/Fiscal Agent. Letters of commitment from all consortium members must be provided along with the respondent's proposal."

If your organization plans to submit as a consortium, letters of commitment from each consortium member would need to be submitted.
